More sandbags being distributed today (Friday)

The State Emergency Service (SES) will have free sandbags available later today (Friday, 1 December) from eight locations in Adelaide, the Mount Lofty Ranges and regional parts of the state.

The eight locations will be open between 11am and 2pm and are as follows:

An SES 'Sandbagging your home' factsheet will be available from each of the eight locations. It provides information on the correct filling, laying and disposal of sandbags. Some locations will also have sand available for residents to fill their own sandbags.

The factsheet is also available on the SES website www.ses.sa.gov.au along with an instructional sandbagging video.

Naracoorte Council also has sandbags available from its depot at the corner of Wrights Road and Wimmera Highway, Naracoorte.

SES State Duty Officer Dr Sara Pulford said the SES was relatively quiet overnight with only 60 requests for SES assistance from the South Australian public.
