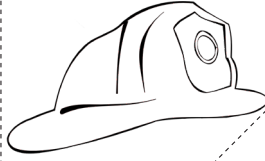

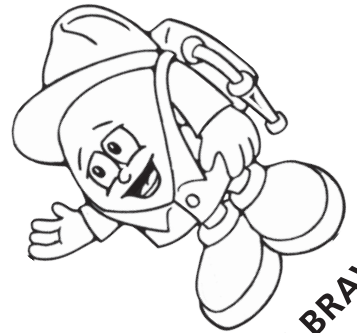

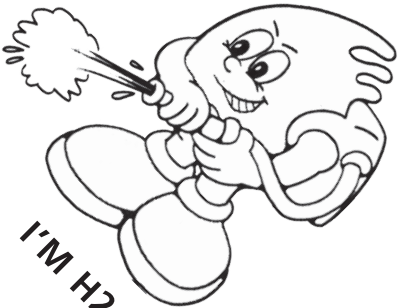

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Colour in the chatterbox with your favourite colours.
2. Place the chatterbox on a flat surface with these instructions facing up.
3. Fold and unfold the Chatterbox along all four lines of symmetry (diagonally, horizontally and vertically). The creases will form a 'star' in the centre of the sheet.
4. Fold each corner into the centre of the 'star' so that they touch but do not overlap.
5. Turn the Chatterbox over.
6. Fold each corner into the centre of the 'star' once more, again so that they touch but do not overlap.
7. Fold and unfold the Chatterbox in half vertically.
8. Fold and unfold the Chatterbox in half horizontally.
9. Ensure your Chatterbox has the four characters facing you.
10. Insert your thumbs and index fingers under the flaps with the pictures.
11. As you pinch your fingers together, the Chatterbox will take shape.
