MFS Response to Fire

MFS would like to reiterate that there is **NO CHARGE** made for attendance at fires within the MFS gazetted boundaries.

If you have a fire in your home you must know how to get out quickly and safely. Develop a home escape plan and practise it so everyone knows,:

- Where possible, two ways to get out of every room in which people may sleep,
- Where to meet after they get out – at the letter box may be the ideal location,
- How to crawl low in smoke (*get down low and go go go!*),
- Know how to unlock doors and windows, leave keys in deadlocks when someone is at home and have quick release catches on security doors and grilles,
- When you get out, STAY OUT and phone 000 from a mobile or neighbour's phone, and wait for instructions,
- Someone should stay near the road to meet the Fire Service.
